Release on March 2006

After having seduced the audience with "APHASIE", first album co-produced with Bertrand Siffert (Young Gods, Noir Désir,...), Water Lily announce the release of a new CD for the 3rd of march 2006 (Phonag Records).

For this new album named "13th floor", the band has collaborated with the excellent english producer, Teo Miller (Placebo, Robert Plant, Martina Topley Bird,...)

The architecture is electric, but doesn't omit some acoustic floors: an old school rock with organic ambients, the material stays solid without disavowing the trace of time.

Thanks to a first demo produced in 1999, the band performed in several national events (Open Air Gampel 2000, Nendaz Francofolies 2000, Balélec 2001, Orgy 4,...) and stirs up the interest of the swiss promoters. So for two years, they travel through most of the french Swiss scene.

In 2002, Water Lily releases under "Label Verte" his first album, "Aphasie". Asserting itself with the original colors of its songs, this production has succeeded in creating enthusiasm.

Co-produced with Bertrand Siffert (Noir Désir Remix, No One Is Innocent, Young Gods,etc.) and distributed in Switzerland by Disques Office, this first album is already viewed as a collector's piece in a sometimes monolithic rock universe.

In 2003, the band perform in several big Open airs such as the Mont-Soleil Festival or the Montreux Jazz Festival and wins, during the professional meeting of M4Music in Zurich, a place on the DIESEL international compilation among more than 600 other bands.

During the same year, Water Lily also wins the first price at the "nouvelles scènes" contest provided by Couleur 3 (Swiss national radio) in the "new trend" category. They join the daily playlists and get a regular broadcast on the national radios.

In january 2004, the band is chosen by the swiss national radio Couleur 3 to represent the new Swiss musical talents at the international showcase "Eurosonic" (NL). Water Lily performed on the same stage than Franz Ferdinand, Ghinzu, AS Dragon,... and was widely acclaimed by the european critics. Back to Switzerland, they end up the Aphasie tour at the Paléo Festival, next to Muse, Emilie Simon and Dionysos and at the Gampel Festival with the Rasmus.
